

San Angelo Bicycling Association (SABA)
Minutes of the monthly membership meeting
July 13, 2011

The monthly meeting was held at the San Angelo Visitors Center. Members and guests in attendance: Christine Buckstead, Velma Ogan, Rick Ogan, Douglas Hackelton, Megan McCulloch, Marlon Miller, Joy Smith, Donna Durbin, David Durbin, Dionnie Hoelsken Roy Jones, Christine Jones.

I. The minutes from the June meeting were posted on the website and approved by the members.

II. Treasurer's Report

Roy Jones distributed the financial statement. The current bank balance is \$4519.98. The fixed expenses have exceeded income from dues and donations by \$300.

The proposed budget was presented to the members. This budget is a guideline and can be amended as needed. A motion was made to approve the budget and the motion passed.

III. Recognition of volunteers

The officers keep track of volunteer efforts, but want to be sure to recognize everyone. The officers are working on a form that can be filled out and submitted for recognition of hours spent on volunteering, but members are also encouraged to submit the information in an email.

IV. 6 Hour Dinosaur Race

- Dionnie presented information on behalf of MAC Racing. Plans for the race are underway. The date being considered is October 15.
- There are some problems obtaining insurance. They are working on finding an alternate insurance company, but the cost will probably be higher than first anticipated.
- Anke and Scott White are working on a t-shirt design that can be coordinated with flyer and promotional designs. They will need the vector file with the SABA logo to send to the t-shirt company.
- State Park permits and insurance need to be in place before any advertising is possible. Kurt anticipates a one-week turnaround on park approval. They hope to have insurance and permits in place by the end of next week.
- Connie has a list of advertising opportunities including ASU, Goodfellow, local bike shops, shops in Abilene and Midland/Odessa, and mtb websites.
- The arrangement with MAC Racing is that SABA will cover upfront expenses and keep any profits. MAC Racing will organize the event. In the case of any profit, SABA will support the MAC Racing team with registration fees at the fall and spring TMBRA series.
- Working on online registration.
- Trophies: Kevin has not committed to building the trophies, but Dionnie has some other possibilities in mind. Another option is the wood shop at Goodfellow.

- Race course - Rick Ogan volunteered to show Dionnie the course that was used in past 6-Hour races.
- Discussion on what time to begin the race, considering number of laps in daylight vs. night time. Also, the state park will charge an additional fee if we stay in the park past 10 PM.
- There is an equestrian event weekend of October 8 - we cannot mark course until after that event. Volunteers are needed for course marking.
- Stephanie Barre is the volunteer contact person at Goodfellow.
- Donna and David Durbin have volunteered to work the rest station at Cougar Outlook during the race.
- Dionnie will talk to Kurt about the risk management plan.
- Christina will take over the planning once she is back in San Angelo.

V. New Business

- MS 150 is this weekend. Marlon Miller will be riding.
- Bill Cullins has asked for cooperation with SABA and local run/bike clubs for the cyclocross series this fall. There may also be a tri-city series for cyclocross. Bill is working on the calendar. He has also sent out a training plan and may offer some workshops. Members discussed that they would be interested in volunteering, participating, and promoting cyclocross in San Angelo.
- Road/MTB duathlon at State Park. There is interest among members to hold this event. A race director is needed. A date will need to be chosen. The first weekend in November was suggested, otherwise hold it in the spring.
- SABA will consider covering park entrance fees for volunteers who do not have park passes.

VI. More New Business

- Members present are asked to help distribute socks to members.
- Next meeting will be August 10.
- September 16 there will be a Health and Fitness Fair at ASU. SABA was invited to put up a booth, but no volunteers are available between 10 and 2 pm to work at the booth.
- The meeting closed at 7:03 PM.
